Families may or will be required to pay for the TGSS fee if one is required for the course you will attend. Please check the level of subsidy with your school as to how much the school will support.</p>		
Pathways	Pathways include further training at ANMEC, TAFE SA and University, and can include Nursing, Allied Health Services, Disability Services, Aged Care and others. Students can also seek employment on completion of this qualification as Personal Care Workers and Orderlies or may choose to continue study in Nursing at a Diploma or Degree level.		
Entry Requirements	To be eligible for TGSS funding students must be 16 years of age. Students must gain a National Police Clearance for SWP. Students must have good literacy and numeracy skills and may be required to undertake an LLN Assessment. Students must attend the ANMEC Open Night.		
Other Requirements	Students will be provided with a uniform shirt and an identification badge. Students must have navy or black pants suitable for work placement. Closed in shoes are also essential at all times. Students also require two large folders and a box of plastic sleeves.
